

MEET OF CHAMPS 2010 - DIVISION II & IV

This information is being provided to help you get acquainted with the Seven Lakes MOC. Below is the link to the interior layout of the pool to help you determine specific entrances, areas, etc.

The area under the covered awning will be reserved for concessions & MOC ready bench. All teams will set-up outside the natatorium. There will be ample room to accommodate your swimmers and parents. It would be a good idea to provide a few garbage bags for your team. This will be helpful in leaving your area clean at the end of the meet. ***DUE TO THE LIMITED SEATING INSIDE THE NATATORIUM, SPECTATORS WILL BE ASKED TO ROTATE IN AND OUT TO WATCH PARTICULAR RACES.***

Swimmers will be ready benched just outside the main entrance. Team ready bench parents will escort their swimmers to the ready bench area. The MOC ready bench volunteers will escort the swimmers into the natatorium through the right door to their lanes. The 10 & under 25 yard events, will start on the bulkhead end of the pool and the 11 & older events, all IMs and all relays will start on the on the "deck" end of the pool. At the end of the race, the swimmers will exit the same way they entered the natatorium.

T-Shirt sales will set up outside just outside the front doors (the north side). Heat Sheets can be purchased at the Chic-Fil-A table located under the covered awning.

Spectators will enter and exit the building through the left door. Remember that all parents want the opportunity to watch their swimmer compete. Please ask parents to be cooperative and respectful of each other by rotating in and out as their swimmer completes an event. **Spectators will not be permitted on the pool deck at any time.** Coaches, meet officials, MOC volunteers and swimmers will be the only ones permitted on the pool deck.

The official results will be posted as events are completed throughout the meet.

The medals area will be located in southeast corner of the natatorium by the diving boards. Be sure to have someone from your team collect your medals at the end of the meet. Please drop your cooler of iced water along this wall first thing in the morning.

I hope this information is helpful. We are all volunteers working together to put on this meet for our kids. If we are patient, understanding and cooperative, we are guaranteed to have had a successful meet at the end of the day.
