

TAAF Regional Meet Info 2010

Event: TAAF Region 14 Qualifying Meet

When: Saturday, July 24, 2010

Where: Cinco Ranch Natatorium

What: TAAF is the ultimate amateur athletic sports festival for Texas athletes. The TAAF games is open to ALL swimmers in the WHALe league, regardless if of whether they participate in the Meet of Champs or All-Star competition.

Cost: The cost is 7.00 per event entry. If you qualify for the state TAAF meet then there will be an entry fee to swim at the state level.

Why? The TAAF Games of Texas is a wonderful and unforgettable event for young athletes. The state games take place in Waco, Texas this year. It can be a fun family weekend. WHALe teams have done well in past years by bringing home their share of medals.

Is there a coach? Yes! We have a super coach named Jessica Louvier. This will be her 3rd year as the coach. She will be at the regional and state meet with the TAAF swimmers and will set up some practices after the regional meet.

State meet? There is a state TAAF meet in Waco. The meet dates are August 5 – 8. Swimmers can swim up to three events. Each age group swims on a different date.

How do I qualify for the state meet? You must swim in the Regional TAAF meet on July 24th. Swimmers can swim up to three events. To qualify for state, you must finish in the top four of your event.

What is the commitment? If you swim in the Regional TAAF meet, then be prepared to go to the state meet in Waco. Some practices will take place between July 12th and August 3rd.
